



Mighty Spirit winds were moving at the 2013 Greater New Jersey Annual Conference. Our first year at the Wildwoods Convention Center proved to be a great success, with wonderful opportunities for worship, fellowship, and holy conferencing. Many hard decisions were made in order to move beyond the declining trends and begin to grow more vital congregations, including the approval of: the Strategic Ministry Plan, the building/purchasing of a new conference center, and A Future with Hope Mission Fund Campaign to begin in the Fall of 2013.

There were many moments to celebrate the ministries of Greater New Jersey as well, including new stages of ministry as seven clergy were ordained into the Order of Elders, six clergy commissioned as provisional clergy members and one as a deacon.
