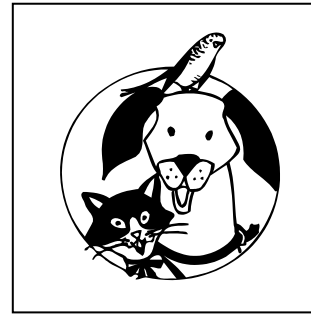

WHEN : Saturday September 14th with Registration and sign-in from 1030am to 1130am, Animal Time!

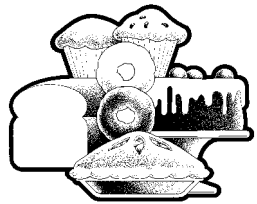

UNITED METHODIST MEN PURPOSE STATEMENT
